UT Dallas Retiree Benefits

The University is generous in its support of medical, dental, life insurance, and other benefits (see <u>Human Resources</u> for the complete package), but there are other perquisites for retirees that you may not know about, including:

• Retirees may purchase (\$18) a **Comet Card** at the Info Depot (Student Center), and they will use it to obtain many additional benefits *below*.

Retirees may retain their University email address (me!@utdallas.edu) to use with their own ISP (Internet Service Provider).

• <u>UTD RA members</u> only are entitled to **on-campus parking** upon completion of a <u>UTD Retiree parking sticker application</u>. Other retirees pay staff rates. As with other parking passes, this is renewed annually, so keep up your membership! The silver tag permits parking in **GREEN**, **GOLD**, and **REMOTE** parking spots only. A \$2 handling fee applies.

Retirees may purchase an Activity Center membership at the faculty/staff rate. Go to the Activity Center to sign up.

• If space is available, retirees over 64 can **audit courses** without charge and can even take **credit courses** without paying tuition. (Fees, however, are not waived.) See the Registrar.

If space is available, retirees may enroll in **computer courses** offered by Information Resources.

• Retirees may attend **cultural events** (for which admission is charged) at the faculty/staff rate, and they may attend cultural events, free to faculty/staff, on presentation of their *Comet Card*.

- Retirees may purchase **discounted tickets** from the Info Depot on presentation of their *Comet Card*.
- · Comet intercollegiate athletic contests are free to retirees presenting their Comet Card.
- Retirees may check out up to five (5) books at one time from the University Library with their Comet Card.

• They may purchase (student-version, discounted) **computer software** (except *Microsoft* and *Adobe*) from the Campus Bookstore **at student prices** with their *Comet Card <u>and UTD email address</u>.*

Finally, retirees with *Comet Cards* get student discounts at several local <u>businesses & eateries</u>!

Many of these benefits were recommended to the University by UTD RA, and, although most accrue to all UTD retirees, you might consider joining UTD RA to encourage further recommendations.

NOTES FROM STAFF COUNCIL

ANNUAL ENROLLMENT

The annual enrollment will be July 15th through the 31st. The Benefits Fair will be available July 19-21 all virtual once again. GOOD NEWS: This will be the fourth year that we will not be having a rate increase.

NEW FUND-RAISING CAMPAIGN

The Office of Development and Alumni Relations has begun a new fund-raising campaign. It is called New Dimensions Campaign. The last campaign was successful and brought in \$250 million dollars and ended in 2018. This campaign's goal is \$750 million. It started May 25th with a public launch and will wrap up in 2025.

HUMAN RESOURCES

Staff are being phased back to campus in August. Each department will handle their phase back differently.

COMET CARDS

There are new comet cards available. Each card will hold more information than the current cards hold. Most specifically, more student info. We are not required to obtain a new card, but if you want one, it will be available.
